Committee Meeting - 1894

August 14/94

The committee on Bethany Cemetery met at the School House on August 14/94 and organized by electing J. C. Shannon, Chairman, C. P. McElwain, Clerk.

First business was to raise money to pay for ground & inclose same, It was voted to put a note in the Bank for two hundred dollars, & to make a fence of three planks & three wires.

R. K. Smith, C. P. McElwain, M. Holliday, John Beckner, J. N. Price was appointed a committee, see to having the land laid off, & proceed. J. N. Price was elected Treasurer of said committee and it was also decided to sell the lots 10x20 for two & one half dollars, until January 1st and then to sell them for five dollars per lot.

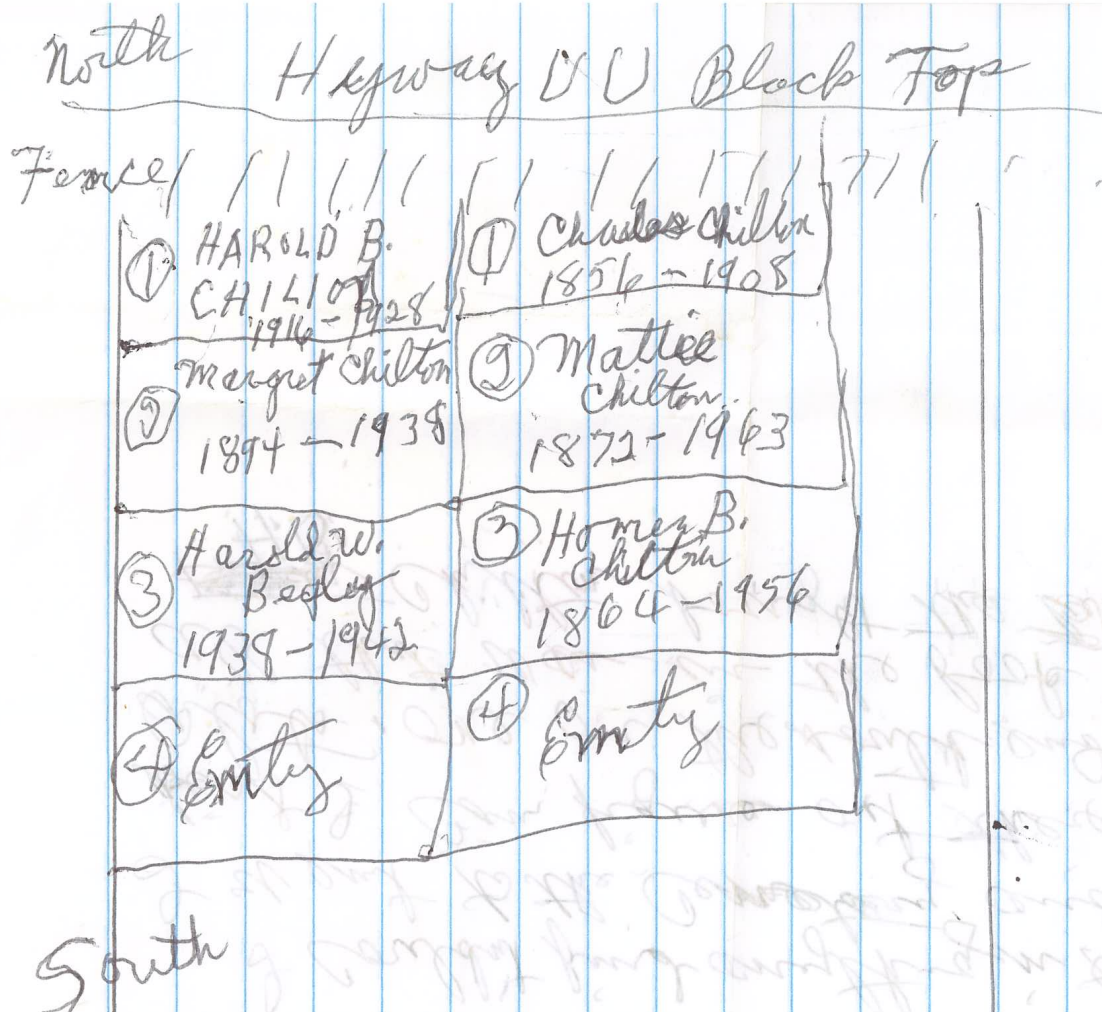



